




Welcome to PS16, your Online Careers Gateway.





Achievement grades 1s & 2s = Level 1 at college

Achievement grades of at least 4 x grade 3s including English Language & Maths = Level 2 at college

Achievement grades of 5 or 6 x grade 4s and above including English Language & Maths = Level 3 BTEC, T Levels and some A levels (check the standard college requirements for Level 3 A level study)


6 or more grade 5s and above including English Language & Maths = Level 3 BTEC, T Levels and A levels (check the specific entry requirements for each A level course as well)





Course Summary

This a level helps students to understand the responsibilities of the accountant and the impacts of their recommendations on the business and the wider environment.

Students will build knowledge and understanding of key concepts, principles and techniques that they can apply to real-life scenarios, developing the ability to solve problems logically, analyse data methodically, make reasoned choices and communicate their findings effectively.

Course content includes analysis and evaluation of financial information, budgeting, accounting for limited companies, capital investment appraisal, and preparation of financial statements.
