Catfishing

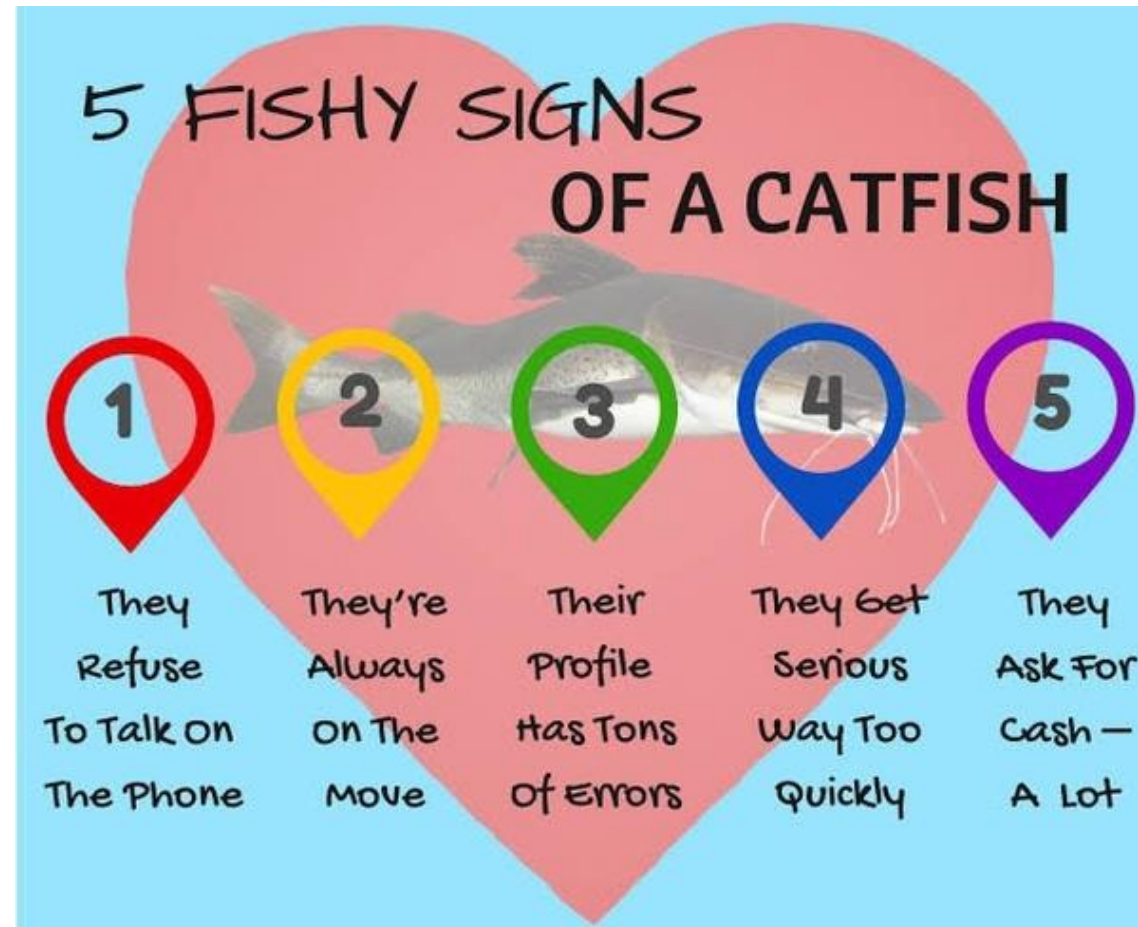


cat·fish [kat-fish] *verb*
