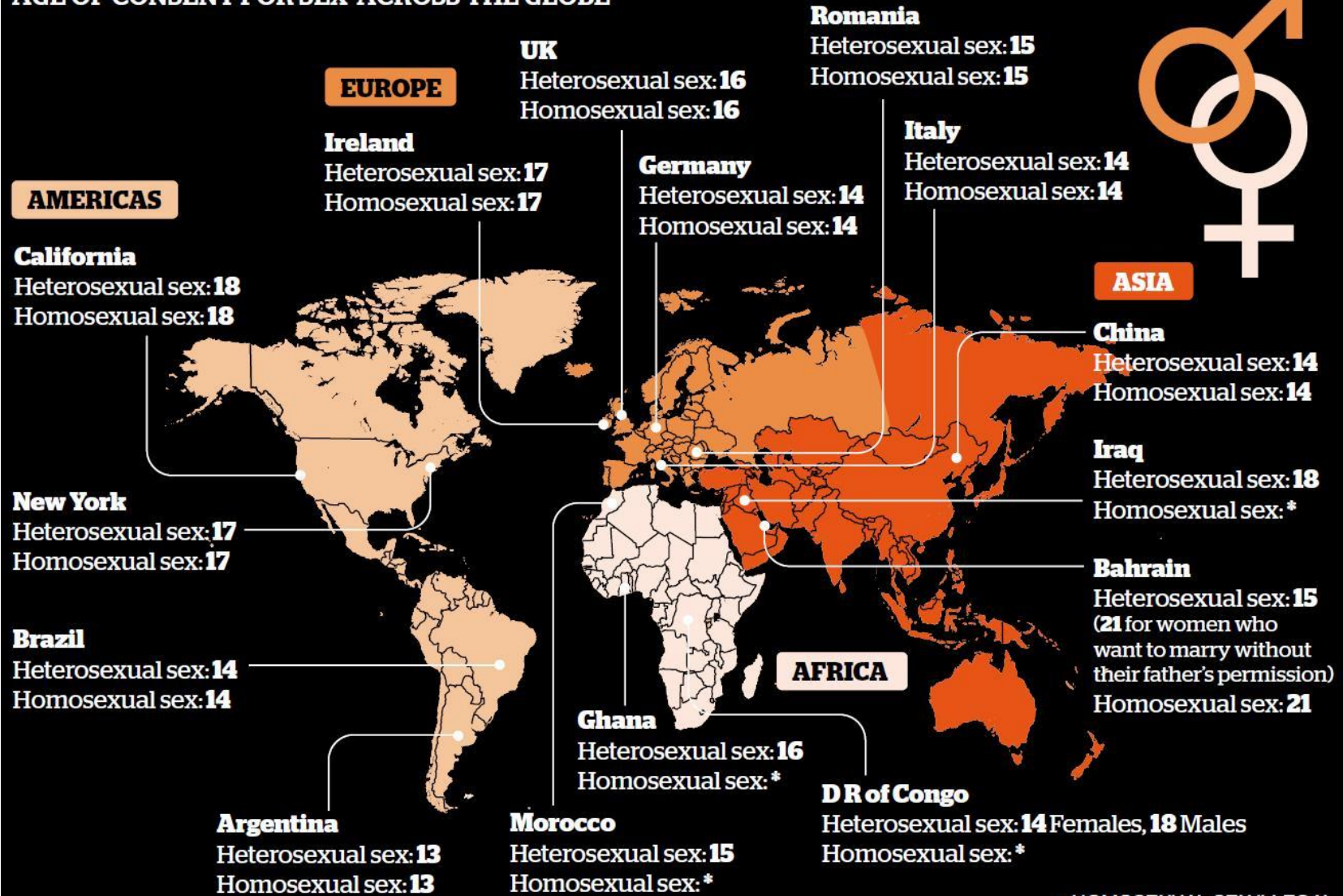

Social norms

Turn and Talk: What percentage of young people do you think are having underage sex in the UK?

Research indicates that 25-30% of young people in the UK have underage sex. This means that approximately 3/4s of young people are not having underage sex.

How to debate?

Listening

- Track the speaker.
- Nod in agreement if you think someone has given a good answer.
- Do not interrupt, listen politely.

Contributing

- Speak Like A Scholar.
- State the extent to which you agree or disagree with the statement.
- Use the sentence stems to add, build or challenge contributions.

Positioning

- You might want to stand to make your point
- Hands up are fine

Chairing

- Scholars can run the debate
- Cold calling is also fine if people are not volunteering
